Actors Who are they?	Agenda What is their explicit agenda?	Arena Where do they act?	Alliances With whom are they coordinating or cooperating?
Name, principal tasks, ascribed role.  Differentiate between key stakeholders (KS), veto players (VP), secondary stakeholders (SS)	Mandate, mission, self-concept, incentives (What are they trying to achieve? What needs make them move? What benefits are they expecting?)	How do they use supporting groups and media? What is their source of legitimation? What are their power resources? (access to financial resources, access to control over infrastructure, control of information and knowledge, threat, etc.)	What are the binding relationships of dependence? Differentiate four types of relationships:  A) Binding dependancy  B) Continuous communication  C) Coordinated action  D) Cooperation, putting together resources
